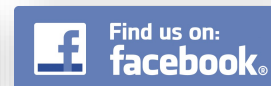

We “got our feet wet” in the Upward ministry by enrolling 18 Denbigh United children/youth in Upward Basketball and Cheerleading at Warwick Memorial United Methodist Church. We also supplied adult volunteers and took many opportunities to learn more about Upward Sports.

We are launching Upward Soccer at Denbigh United in August. Much work is being done to prepare the field. We were blessed to purchase much of the needed soccer equipment from Temple Baptist, and then we received a donation to cover the cost. Our current challenge is transporting the goals from Temple Baptist to Denbigh United. If you have a vehicle or trailer that could be used, please call the church office.

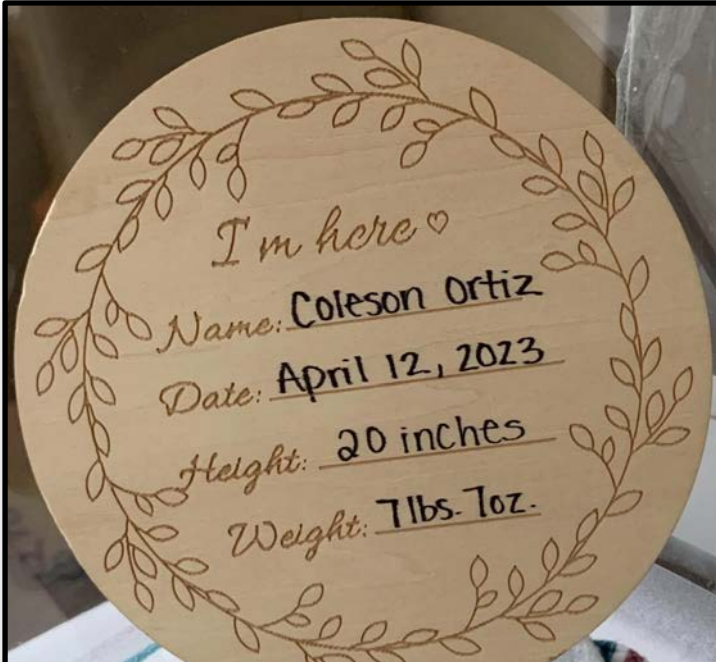

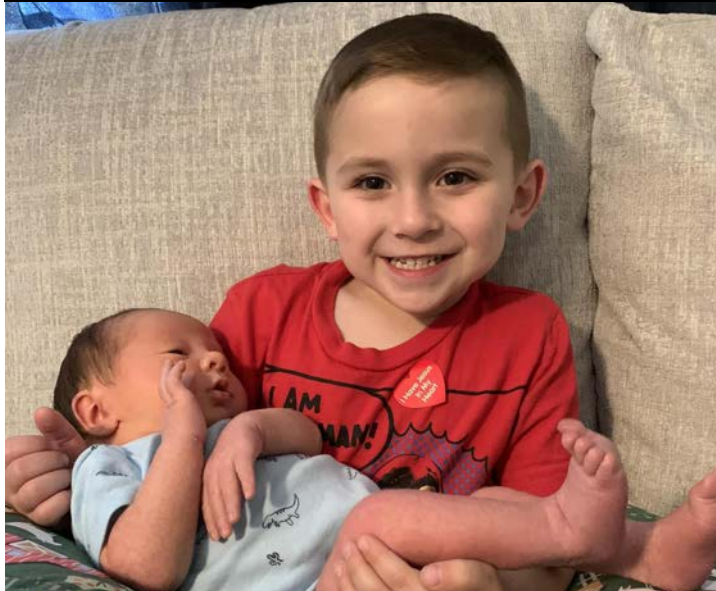

Living with Grief Workshop

The Congregational Care Committee is pleased to announce our first *Living with Grief Workshop* on Wednesday, May 17, 2023 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. We are grateful that this interactive presentation will be led by Carol Taliaferro, a Licensed Clinical Social Worker who has extensive grief therapy experience.

Grief is a natural response to loss. There is no time limit or right/wrong way of how an individual grieves. Experiencing many difficult and unexpected emotions of a tremendous loss is normal, but it can be scary **and unsettling to the one feeling the moods. Coping with the loss can be one of life's biggest challenges**, whether it has been days or years since your loss, each person heals in their own time. Trying to ignore **your pain, 'stuff it', or put on a brave front to keep it from surfacing will only make it worse in the long run.** For real healing, it is necessary to face your grief and actively deal with it.

In our 1 day, 2-hour workshop, we will talk about grief, the effects it has on us, both physically and emotionally, how to navigate the many emotions, and how to begin to move through this journey toward healing our broken hearts.

Our workshop is for those who have experienced the loss of a loved one and/or for those who want to be **supportive to them. We WELCOME you to come join us, talk or just listen to others' stories and experiences.** Sharing your story is not necessary.

The Congregational Care Committee is considering a grief group to begin in the fall on a monthly or weekly basis. Please see Marlene Ferri or call 757-291-6425 to find out more information.

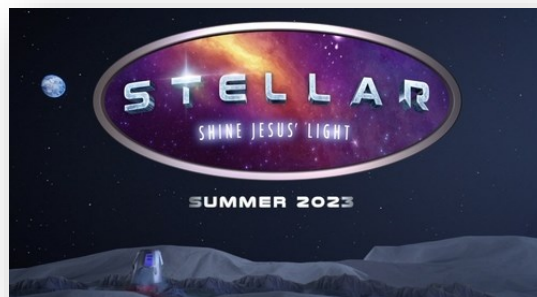
Sunday School Classes

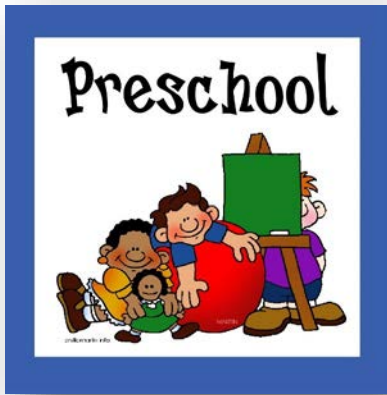

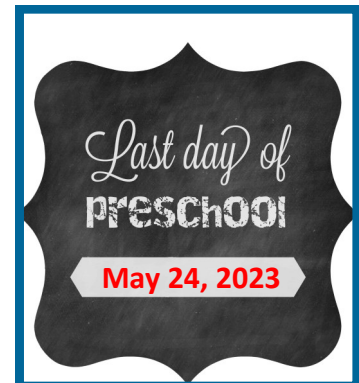
Thank you for welcoming our preschool families to Preschool Sunday. We hope you enjoyed seeing all of the fun and creative art we do during our busy day.
