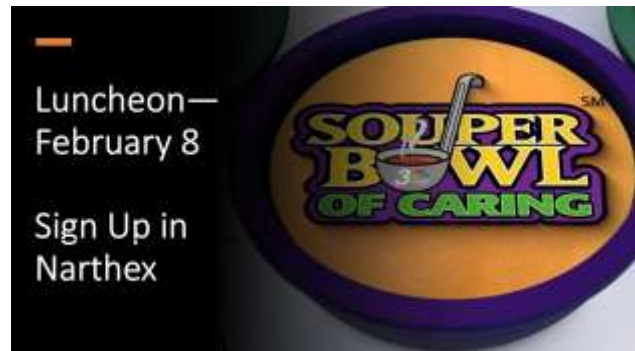

Individual/Family Needs

- Provided financial assistance for rent to two community members.
- Purchased work pants for a DUPC member starting a new job.

Paul's Ministry

- In January, members of DUPC transported children from Paul's Mobile Home Park and surrounding areas to attend Sunday School, Worship, Chimes Choir, Faith Weaver Friends, and to Warwick Memorial UMC for basketball and cheerleading practices and games.

Clothing and More Giveaway

- The last Clothing and More Giveaway was on Sunday, November 30. The next date is to be determined.
- We will not be accepting donations for an undetermined period of time due to health concerns currently limiting our team members.

Evangelism

- In January, our worship service was viewed 767 times on Facebook, and 111 times on YouTube.





THRIVE

- A small insight into 2025:
 - 79% of the recipients of the, Let Christmas Thrive, gift certificates for their children, said it enabled them to stay current with their bills.
 - 58% of the clients that took advantage of the Food Lock (outdoor lockers) said they would have had no other way to access food that week.
 - The majority of the families that requested THRIVE's assistance are working families.
 - THRIVE added Saturday hours at The Market for working families.
 - THRIVE responded during the Federal shutdown by serving 240 furloughed families.
 - THRIVE had 300 volunteers working in 2025.
 - THRIVE earned 18 media placements.
- Pantry needs: strawberry jelly, Ramen noodles, canned fruit, baking items/mixes, mixed vegetables, diaper sizes 4-6



Menchville House

- In 2025, Menchville House:
 - Sheltered dozens of families and over 100 individuals, including many children
 - Provided three meals a day, safe housing, and case management services
 - Hosted and participated in four major fundraising events, community drives, and volunteer days
 - Expanded financial literacy education, mentorship, and life skills programs
 - Continued their commitment to moving families from crisis to confidence
- The Langley Federal Credit Union's, Langley for Families Foundation, provided Menchville House with a grant of \$15,000.



Virginia Peninsula Foodbank (VPF)

- Monday, January 19, was the 10th annual MLK Day of Caring Food Drive from 9 a.m.-1 p.m. at the VPF. The City of Newport News, elected officials, and Riverside Health Services, along with community support came together to make a difference with neighbors, and honor the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
- VPF saw a 30% increase in 2025 with requests for food assistance.
