## Outreach



### Individual/Family Needs

- Three hundred ninety-two (392) pounds of food were donated by the congregation for DUPC's Souper Bowl of Caring. The food was sorted and bagged by the youth, and it was delivered to THRIVE Peninsula to provide to the individuals and families in our community experiencing food insecurity.

### Paul's Ministry

- In February, members of DUPC provided transportation to children from Paul's Mobile Home Park, and surrounding areas, to attend Sunday School, Worship, Children's Handchimes Choir, Faith Weaver Friends, and to Warwick Memorial UMC for basketball and cheerleading practices and games.
- A used stove was purchased and delivered to a family associated with DUPC.

### PORT

- PORT guests were welcomed on Wednesday, February 18, and they will be staying with us until the morning of Wednesday, March 4. The PORT shelter will close two weeks after the guests leave us. Please keep them in your prayers as they face so many physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual challenges, day in and day out, on our streets. And pray that countless individuals and organizations will continue reaching out to them so they can attain the stability, independence, and the permanent housing they deserve. ## THRIVE

- DUPC collected and delivered 392 lbs. of food for THRIVE from our Souper Bowl of Caring on February 8, 2026.
- The differences between critical bill assistance from 2021-2025 is amazing. In 2015, \$18,050 was distributed to 82 families. In 2025, \$538,290 was distributed to 476 families.
- THRIVE will host an **Extreme Couponing Workshop**, Saturday, March 7, 10:00 a.m.-12:00 noon, at THRIVE, 12749 Nettles Drive, Newport News.
- Pantry needs: strawberry jelly, Ramen noodles, canned fruit, baking items/mixes, mixed vegetables, and canned fruit



## Menchville House

- Homelessness is not just funded by local services, but by federal policy and organizations like the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Lawmakers in congress have introduced a bill, the Ending Homelessness Act of 2025(H.R. 4872) designed to create a more coordinated national strategy to end homelessness, that is still under consideration. Understanding federal policy can help us all advocate to help end homelessness, and take the burden off of organizations such as Menchville House.
