



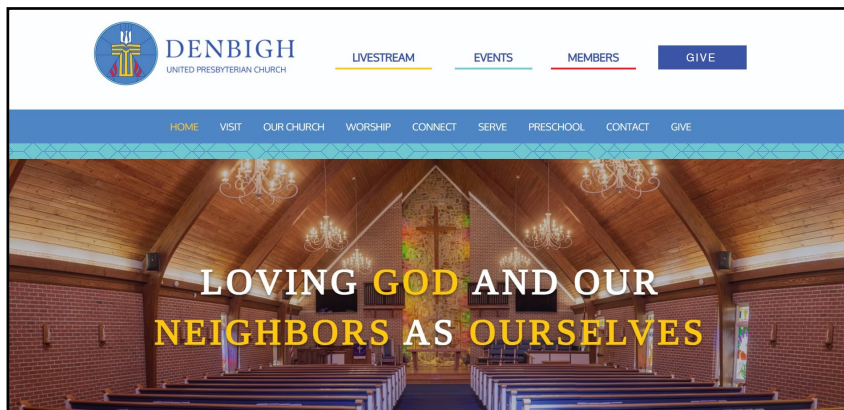

## Onesimus Projects Update: PEP (Parents As Educational Partners)

God answers prayers in many and varied ways. Our Onesimus Project Grant includes the Learn English/Learn Spanish Program which we proposed. We struggled with how to launch this program and were helped by a fellow Presbyterian to build a partnership with Newport News Public School System (NNPS) and their English as a Second Language (ESL) program.

NNPS needed a partner to host and provide transportation, dinner, and children's/youth activities while their parents learn more English and more about the school system and how it works.

The 10-session Parents as Education Partners (PEP) program began on June 25 as a beautiful collaboration with the school system and the church. Spanish-speaking families from Paul's Mobile Homes Park are attending.

Church volunteers are providing a delicious family meal each night of the program along with nursery, recreation, music, crafts, and more for the children and teens. Parents are learning how to navigate the school system and how to be stronger partners with their children as they receive their education.

Thank you to all of our Denbigh United volunteers and to the ESL staff from NNPS. It is a joyful partnership which we hope will continue as we serve the Paul's community and as we also strive to learn Spanish and teach English!

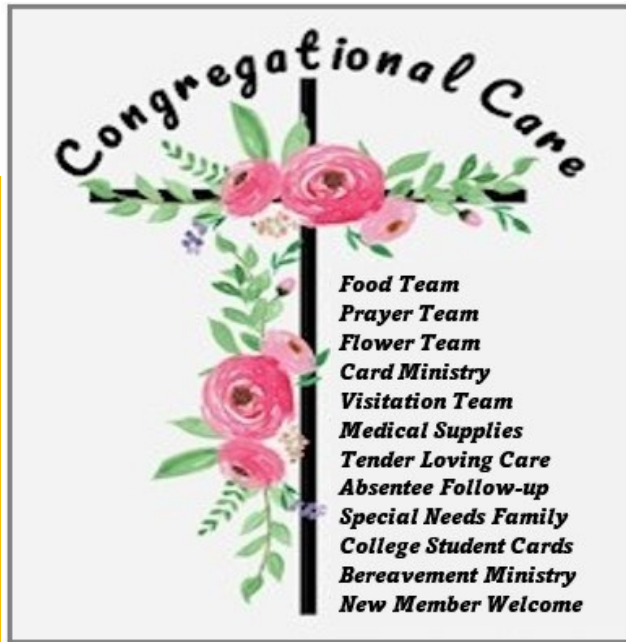

# Outreach



## Individual/Family Needs

- Provided non-food items to a community member associated with DUPC.
- Delivered two twin mattresses, two twin foundations, one full mattress, one mattress topper, and bedding to a community family associated with DUPC. All of the items were donated with the exception of a twin mattress which was purchased at the Restore.

## Paul's Ministry

- Children from Paul's Mobile Home Park and other locations were transported by DUPC to Sunday School in June.
- Some of the children have expressed an interest in playing soccer at DUPC in the fall.

## Vaccine Clinic

- DUPC hosted another booster clinic with Denbigh Pharmacy on Saturday, June 17. Seventy-five (75) booster shots were administered. Many participants expressed their sincere appreciation for this opportunity provided to them. Thank you to all of the DUPC volunteers who made it possible.

## Virginia Peninsula Foodbank

- June 12 is the kick off for the Summer Food Service program. This is free of charge for those 18 years of age and younger, in the greater Peninsula area. The Virginia Peninsula Foodbank will be providing around 1,000 free breakfasts and lunches this summer, Monday thru Friday, to ensure children do not go hungry. Volunteers and students from their Culinary Training program will prepare the bag lunches and hot meals.

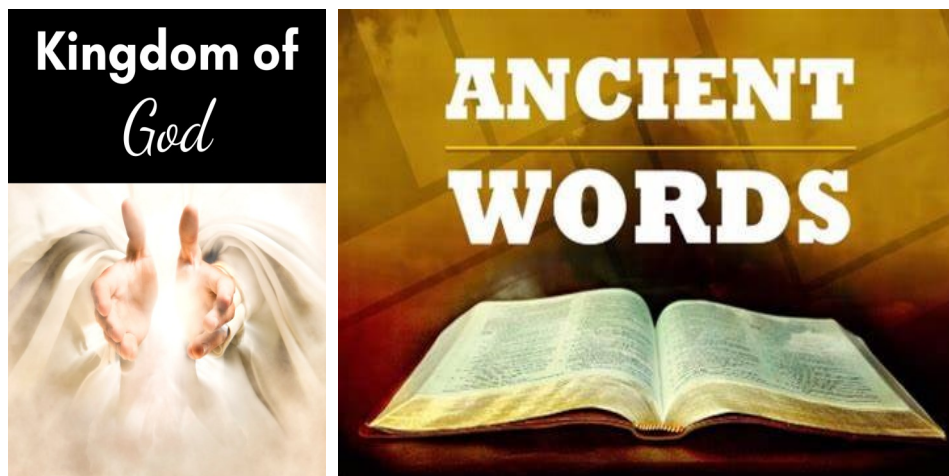
### My Star Word—July Reflections

Share your word with others

- ◆ Ask someone close to you if they have noticed a change that might have something to do with the word or how they see you and that word fitting together.
- ◆ Write a prayer or poem about your journey with your word or create a piece of art or music based on your word and what you've learned about it and through it so far. Share it with others.
- ◆ Have a discussion with some others about the meaning of the word.
- ◆ In the winter month of January, we think about stars because the nights are long and the days are short. In July, it's the opposite. We see the sun more than the stars. Cut out a paper sun to write your word on this month to remind you that our paths are lit by different kinds of light during different seasons.

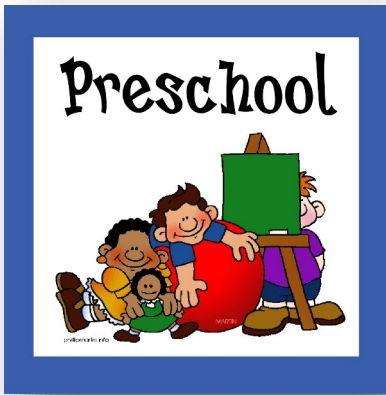

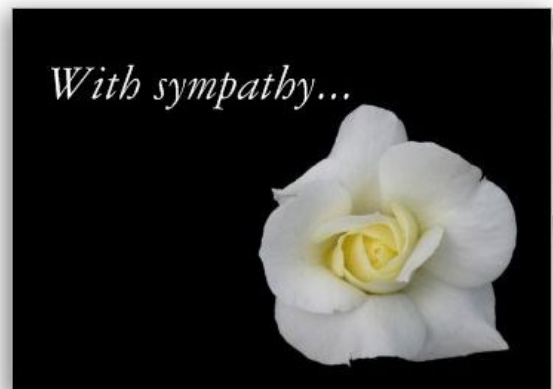
