March 28—Maundy Thursday Service, 7 p.m.





Bread Fundraiser a Success

Thank you to *Marlene Ferri* for making and selling loaves of delicious bread again this year. The fundraiser netted \$1,462 and will be used for improvements to the accessibility and appearance of the Office Entrance vestibule (glassed in area). These funds will be added to what was raised through bread sales last year. We will continue to raise funds and pursue grants for this project.

Some fun facts about the bread baking process. Marlene spent 416 hours on this project, including the baking time! It took 175 pounds of flour, 6 pounds of sugar, 5.5 pounds of brown sugar, 2.25 liters of oil, and 1.5 liters of potato flakes. No wonder we are a few pounds heavier!



We are hoping to get a snow day or two! Last month, in January, we made our own snow in each class. The four-year-olds carried out lots of science experiments with ice and water.




